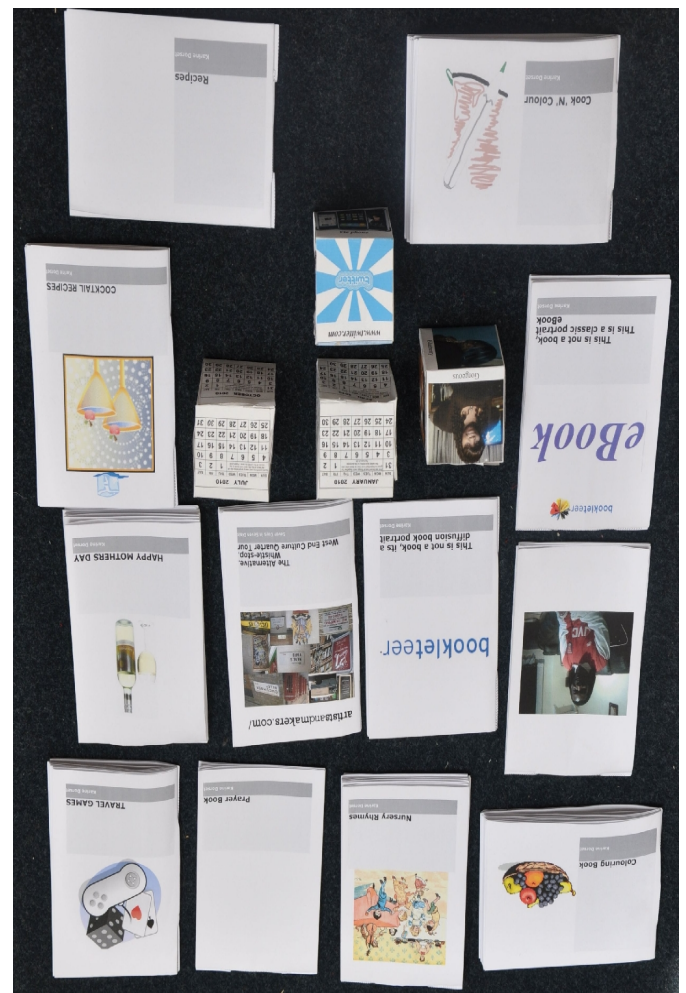
A series of eBooks that the family can use to enjoy together

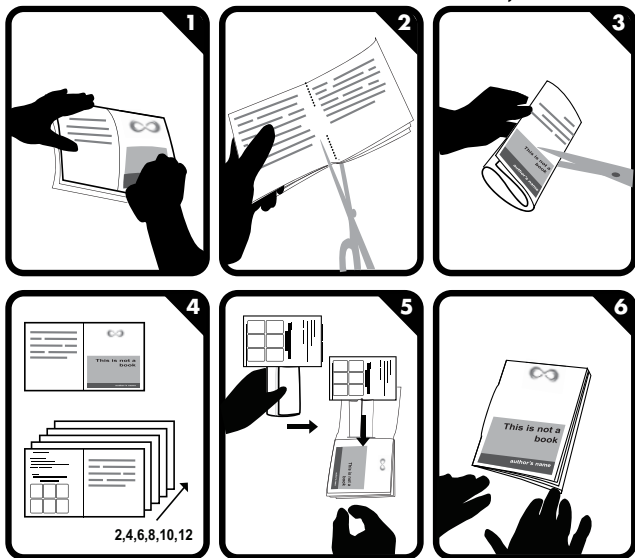
Designed cubes that tell different stories

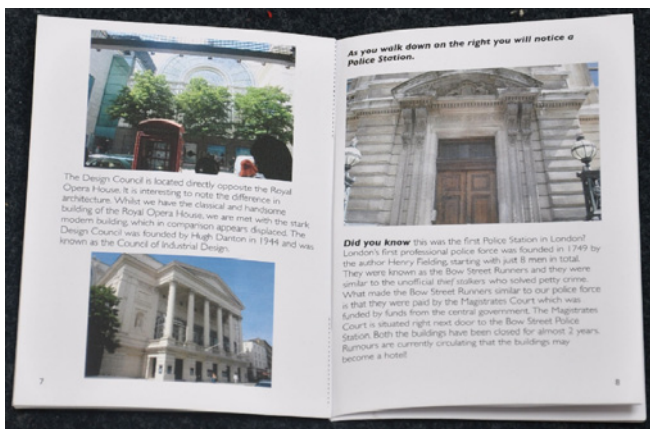

From 5th till the 9th of July my work colleague, my boss and I worked on a project about an alternative tour on west end culture called 'Seven Dials in Seven Days' and it was based in a shop on Earlham street, in the heart of Covent Garden. The Alternative Whistle-stop West End Culture Quarter Tour was an eBook I created based on this project.

It's about another way of seeing West End Culture in Covent Garden. The eBook is built up of photographs taken on the tour, information that was researched and addresses of the seven culture attractions in Covent Garden. It took a total of four days to research and put together, with help of a writing team of FJF(Future Job Funds) Placements. It was a bit of panic to finish but I'm happy with the end result.

This eBook was based on the idea of transforming a Mothers or Fathers Day card into a personal designed Mothers or Fathers day eBook. The book design template was an A4 classic portrait.

I took pictures from home, wrote my own poems and searched for some quotes, Mother and Father.

The Mothers Day eBook was created on 11th March 2010 and the Fathers Day eBook was created on 18th June 2010.

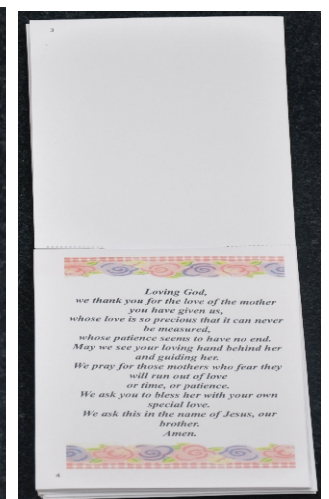
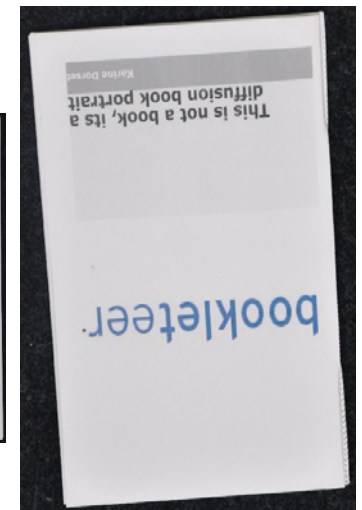
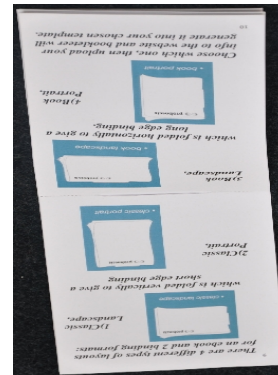

Colouring Book

The Colouring book was an eBook designed and created using NeoOffice, OpenOffice and Firefox. The idea was to get all types of images from animals, to places, from food to people etc, for children to get creative and colour. It was also designed for travel fun but can be used where ever, whenever. But it's not just a colouring book, it has a bit more activities. You can fill in the images by numbers allocated to the right colour, or just write about the image that you did colour.

I printed the images from the internet, traced them, scanned them and add numbers, lines or quotes were it was needed.

Recipes

Diffusion book/classic portrait

Diffusion book portrait and classic portrait was an eBook created to show potential users of Proboscis' Bookleeter website what it's all about.

This eBook tells you about eBooks and StoryCubes, what you can do with them and how to make them. The name book portrait or classic portrait is the template layout.

I put together the text for my knowledge and understanding of bookleeter, eBooks and StoryCubes. Gathering picture and content consisted of logos from Proboscis, diagrams from the Bookleeter and Proboscis website. Scans from my own eBooks, and sticker templates were also used.

It was completed 18th March 2010.
