

How often do you go to the village stream to collect water?

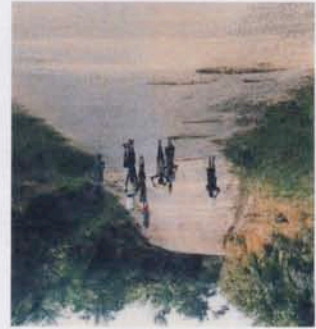


I always go to the village stream to collect water every day.

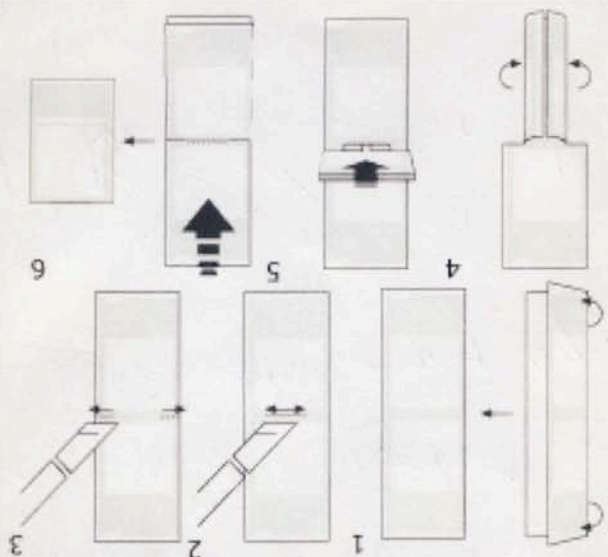
