It takes me ^{about} 25 minutes to walk to the village stream from my home / house

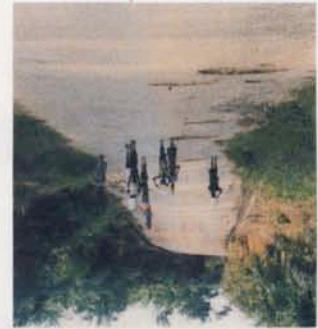

Yes, ~~the road~~ Uzo Umufarange.

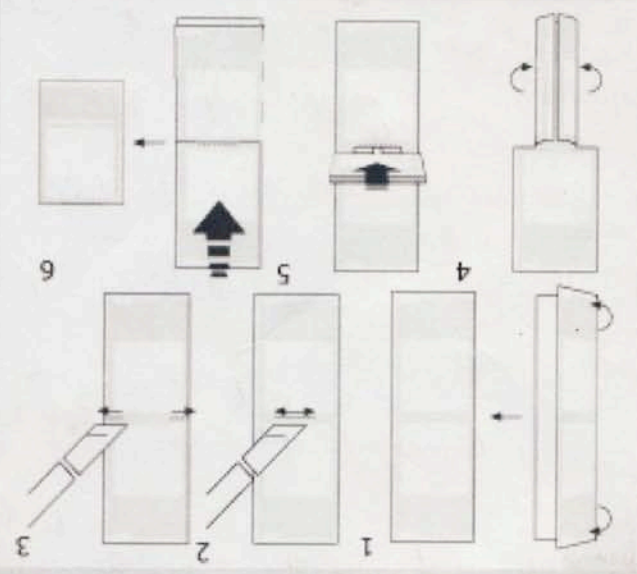
Why is the ground so dry?
