


# The Accidental Menagerie Book Three

Andrew & Maggie Hunter

1658: John Evelyn recalls in his diary that a whale 58 feet long appeared in the Thames between Deptford and Greenwich and "drew an infinite Concourse to see it, by water, coach, on foot from Lond, & all parts". It was "killed with the harping yrons & struck in the head, out of which spouted blood & water, by two tunnels like Smoake from chimney: & after an horrid grone it ran quite on shore & died".
